Agenda:

1. Networking – Sharing Plans from Conferences
 - a. Southwest Region Conf – next week is SWRC Camporee, for TLTs, doing recruiting to get PF to turn in their TLT Application & Recommendation Forms.
 - b. Greater New York Conf – finished the first convention for the year. Last weekend a PF Camporee but not much details for the TLTs. Many involved in PBE. Next Conv scheduled for Oct. Interest is still growing. Our challenge is the Director's involvement. Mentorship is picking up a bit. Our first convention we had a lot of mentors participating with the young people.
 - c. Kansas-Nebraska Conf – we are just beginning our TLT program from the conference level. We are figuring out our calendar and planning for leadership training. We have a big interest in the older TLTs getting their MG.
 - d. Lake Region Conf – not much to share on TLT. Just finished our honors retreat.
 - e. South Central Conf – We are in the process of training our coordinators and directors on board and to understand the program. We do have TLTs in our conference, but they are not yet registered with the conference.
 - f. Quebec Conf – We have one planning for virtual camporee planned. After that a camp for MG in Sept.
 - g. Gulf States Conf – new TLT Coordinator for PF Club in Birmingham. We have TLTs but have not organized them
 - h. Texico Conf – our Conf PF Director retired. The Area Coordinators have gathered to continue until they get a new PF Director. Doing all our training virtually.
 - i. Southern New England Conf – we had our TLT giveback weekend at the Adventurer Fun Escape. They helped with inspection, games, small centers with the staffs. We are planning for our TLT Convention. Still deciding if it will be in-person or online.



2. BTP Camporee 2024 NAD TLT Headquarters Team Development

- a. NAD Club Ministries and NAD Education are collaborating to make the TLT Volunteer opportunities a huge success
- b. Plans are developing for the NAD Education department to run the TLT Headquarters
- c. Things we learned from the 2019 Chosen Camporee:
 - I. TLT Volunteer Days – at the 2019 CIC Camporee we learned that TLTs do not show up for volunteering until Wed morning. The days with the strongest TLT volunteering was Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. We planned for a Sabbath afternoon TLT Rally at the TLT headquarters and only had 4 clubs show up with about 40 TLTs.
 - II. Volunteer Hours – 4-hour blocks worked well (9:00 am-1:00 pm and 1:00-5:00 pm)
 - III. TLTs & Staff earned a Camporee TLT Volunteer Pin by serving for 4 hours minimum. (about 350 earned the pin)
 - IV. TLTs & Staff earned Earn a Camporee TLT Volunteer T-shirt and a letter by serving 16 hours minimum (about 42 earned the t-shirt)
 - V. Volunteering can be done at conference or union headquarters, honors, booths, as well as with the Camporee services through the TLT Headquarters

3. TLT Coordinator Training – Module 2 – TLT Programs & Operations

- a. Update your Club's Handbook using the Club Orientation Program (COP) Pg 10
- b. TLT Duties (Pg 11-12) – be flexible with the 80% attendance requirement – especially as TLTs get into Level 3 and 4. If not clubs may lose their TLTs because of school requirements
- c. Operational Key Words (Pg 16 sidebar) – use key words and concepts to think beyond just Operations Tasks. As a mentor always be thinking about TLTs working in groups, as well as giving them opportunities to “develop” new projects or things related to Pathfinder ministry beyond their club.
